SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES FOR THE LOGO COMPETITION FOR THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CARIBBEAN COMMUNITY

1. The Secretary-General of the Caribbean Community (CARICOM) refers to the following decision of the Forty-Ninth Meeting of the Community Council of Ministers (May 2022, Guyana), with regard to the Draft Programme for the observance of the Fiftieth Anniversary of the Caribbean Community:

**SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES FOR THE LOGO COMPETITION FOR THE
50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CARIBBEAN COMMUNITY**

“THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL:

Agreed that the CCA would support the elaboration of a regional approach for the 50th anniversary celebrations, and would assist in the review and refinement of the Draft Plan and Preliminary List of Activities before submission to Heads.”

2. Member States will recall information shared via Savingsgrams 492 and 501 of 2022 in August 2022 regarding the submission of entries for the Slogan and Logo competitions for the 50th Anniversary of the Caribbean Community.
3. Member States are advised that the Slogan competition was completed and the Secretary-General has approved the following slogan:

“50 Years Strong: A Solid Foundation to Build On”

4. The Secretariat advises Member States of the launching of the Logo competition and encourages Member States to publish the Logo competition advertisement on **21 December 2022** giving five weeks to the final date for submissions which is **25 January 2023**.
5. **Member States are reminded that the Guidelines for the Logo competition were previously provided under cover of Savingsgrams 492 and 501 of 2022, but are attached for ease of reference.**
6. Member States are requested to screen the submissions received and submit their **five (5)** national selections to the Secretariat by **10 February 2023**.
