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SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES FOR THE SLOGAN AND LOGO COMPETITIONS FOR THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CARIBBEAN COMMUNITY

1. The Caribbean Community (CARICOM) Secretariat refers to the following decision of the Forty-Ninth Meeting of the Community Council of Ministers (May 2022, Guyana) regarding the Draft Programme for the observance of the Fiftieth Anniversary of the Caribbean Community:

THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL:

“Agreed that the CCA would support the elaboration of a regional approach for the 50th anniversary celebrations, and would assist in the review and refinement of the Draft Plan and Preliminary List of Activities before submission to Heads.”

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2. The Sixteenth Meeting of the **CARICOM Committee of Ambassadors** (July 2022) agreed:
 - to establish National Committees as an intermediate mechanism to manage the process of evaluating the submissions from entrants within their respective jurisdictions for both the Logo and Slogan competitions;
 - that a maximum of five (5) entries will be submitted to the Secretariat for final review;
 - to the need for anonymity of entries at the final stage and that the proposals be identified entirely on merit.

3. The Secretariat hereby submits the following to the CARICOM Committee of Ambassadors (In French and Dutch - Unofficial):
 - (i) Guidelines for the Slogan and Logo Competitions;
 - (ii) Entry Forms for the Slogan and Logo Competitions;
 - (iii) Draft Advertisement to be used

4. The Regional Judging panel will consist of one (1) representative from the Member States of the current Bureau (3), one member of the CARICOM Youth Ambassadors and one member of Secretariat Staff, for a total of five (5).

5. The CARICOM Committee of Ambassadors is required to transmit to the Secretariat the following information for their Member State by **19 August 2022**.

6. The Secretariat strongly encourages Member States to publish the competition advertisement on **22 August 2022** giving three weeks. The final date for submissions is **9 September 2022**.

7. Member States are requested to submit their five (5) national selections to the Secretariat by **23 September 2022**.

8. **The Logo competition will follow the conclusion of the Slogan competition. The winning Slogan will be provided to the entrants for the Logo competition. The Secretariat will advise Member States of the date for the launch of the Logo completion.**
